January 13, 2009 Meeting**

Randy moved to open the meeting at 6:04 pm, seconded by Palmer and approved.

Brian Roy discussed a payment plan with the Selectmen to pay his grandmothers taxes. Francis moved to approved a payment of \$300/wk, seconded by Randy and approved.

Francis moved to accept the January 6, 2008 Minutes and Non-Public Minutes, seconded by Randy and approved.

Chief Kevin Kay advised Police Officer Pivirotto would start at the police academy this Saturday. Selectmen requested the Chief purchase gasoline locally if it is less than the \$2.09 a gallon charged at the state shed.

Selectmen signed abatement for Kesek M/L 02-02-05, 2008 equalization assessment certificate, 2009 testing proposal from Provan & Lorber for the Transfer Station, and authorized payment to Winterset.

Selectmen reviewed the Warrant Article submitted by Mr. Melanson and will put it on the Warrant this year. Palmer moved to amend the wording as necessary, seconded by Randy and approved.

Randy moved, seconded by Francis, and approved by Palmer, to go into non-public session per RSA 91-A:3, II (c) at 6:50 pm, to discuss matters which, if discussed in public, would likely affect adversely the reputation of any person. Randy moved to come out of non-public session at 7:10 pm, seconded by Francis and approved by Palmer. No decisions were made.

Randy moved, seconded by Francis, and approved by Palmer, to go into non-public session per RSA 91-A:3, II (c) at 7:10 pm, to discuss matters which, if discussed in public, would likely affect adversely the reputation of any person. Francis moved, seconded by Randy and approved by Palmer to come out of non-public session at 7:22 pm. It was agreed more paperwork is required before a decision can be made.

Mary Davis talked to Selectmen about overdue taxes and tax deeding. Mary said she would call DRA to ask for help on how to do the deeding. She also said she has a letter in her computer that can be sent to property owners advising of pending action by the Town.

Randy moved, seconded by Francis, and approved by Palmer, to go into non-public session per RSA 91-A:3, II (c) at 7:55 pm, to discuss matters which, if discussed in public, would likely affect adversely the reputation of any person. Francis moved, seconded by Randy and approved by Palmer to come out of non-public session at 8:25 pm. The Administrative Assistant updated Selectmen on legal issues. No decisions were made.

Randy moved to adjourn the meeting at 8:30 pm, seconded by Francis, and approved.
