ARTICLE 1: Bonds or Notes for CTE Area

To see if the School District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of eight million five hundred forty-seven thousand two hundred fifty-one dollars (\$8,547,251) for the renovation of the CTE Center (Vocational Wing), and to authorize the issuance of not more than eight million five hundred forty-seven thousand two hundred fifty-one dollars (\$8,547,251) of bonds or notes in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Finance Act (RSA 33) and to authorize the School Board to issue and negotiate such bonds or notes and to determine the rate of interest thereon. And further, to raise and appropriate forty-three thousand nine hundred fifty-eight dollars (\$43,958) for the payments due during the 2017-2018 school year.

The School Board **recommends** this article. (3/5 vote required)

ARTICLE 2: Negotiate and Execute Tuition Contracts

To see if the School District will vote to authorize the School Board to negotiate and execute such tuition contracts as the Board may determine advisable for students inside or outside the Pemi-Baker Regional School District. The School Board **recommends** this article. (Majority vote required.)

ARTICLE 3: Authorize Special Education Borrowing

To see if the School District will vote to authorize and empower the School Board to borrow up to one hundred four thousand dollars (\$104,000) representing a portion of the State of New Hampshire's share of special education costs for the 2017-2018 school year, pursuant to RSA 198:20-d upon such terms and conditions as the School Board determines in the best interests of the District, said sum together with the costs of borrowing to be repaid by the State of New Hampshire pursuant to RSA 198:20-d, or to take any action in relation thereto. The School Board **recommends** this article. (Majority vote required.)

ARTICLE 4: School Board Contingency Fund

To see if the School District will vote to establish a contingency fund in accordance with Revised Statutes Annotated 198:4-b, such contingency fund to meet the cost of unanticipated expenses that may arise during the year and, further, to raise and appropriate the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for such contingency fund. The School Board **recommends** this article. (Majority vote required.)

ARTICLE 5: Teacher Agreement

To see if the School District will vote to approve the cost items included in a collective bargaining agreement reached between the School Board and the Plymouth Regional Educator's Association, which calls for the following increases in salaries and benefits:

Year	Estimated Increase

2018-2019	\$112,782
2019-2020	\$113,967
2020-2021	\$115,913

And further to raise and appropriate the sum of one hundred twelve thousand one hundred sixty-two dollars (\$112,162) for the 2017-2018 fiscal year, such sum representing the additional costs attributable to the increase in salaries and benefits over those of the appropriation at current staffing levels in accordance with the most recent collective bargaining agreement. The School Board **recommends** this article. (Majority vote required.)

ARTICLE 6: Operating Budget

To see if the Pemi-Baker Regional School District will vote to raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session for the purposes set forth therein, totaling fourteen million, one hundred eighty-nine thousand four hundred eighty-two dollars (\$14,189,482).

Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be thirteen million nine hundred ninety eight thousand two hundred eighteen dollars (\$13,998,218), which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Pemi-Baker Regional School Board, or by law or the governing body may hold one special meeting. In accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only. This sum excludes the sums in Warrant Articles 1, 4, and 5. The School Board **recommends** this article. (Majority vote required.)
